St. John's Rehab is the site of Ontario's only dedicated burn rehabilitation program. Our highly skilled rehabilitation professionals work with patients and their families to customize care plans for people with severe burns or electrical contact injuries. The hospital is a provincial centre on the forefront of teaching and research in burn care.

From the inpatient unit, patients can be discharged to the hospital's outpatient programs, which include a comprehensive outpatient service and the Back on Track specialty clinic for clients of the Workplace Safety and Insurance Board. Patients with burns sustained in motor vehicle accidents are also referred to Back on Track.

Burn clinics are held at the hospital and involve specialists at Sunnybrook's Ross Tilley Burn Centre and at Hamilton Health Sciences Centre.

St. John's Rehab offers access to rehab 7 days per week. Length of stay varies depending on the complexity of care needs.

Our interprofessional team works with patients and their families to promote independence and optimal health through:

- Developing and reviewing functional goals, care plans and discharge timelines
- Intensive pain, skin and wound management
- Support groups to respond to patients' psychological and social needs and to encourage development of strategies for coping and self-management
- Consultation with an external network of acute burn specialists, as needed.
- Coordination of home care services by our on-site Community Care Access Centre Coordinator

OUTPATIENT REHABILITATION

We provide a continuum of care for our discharged inpatients and patients referred from throughout Ontario. Our ambulatory care program offers specialized assessments and treatments, including:

- Comprehensive, multidisciplinary care such as physiotherapy, occupational therapy, psychiatry and nursing clinics

- Wound management
- Speech-language pathology
- Psychosocial and psychological support
- Customized splints and face masks

Were you involved in a motor vehicle or work-related accident?

St. John's Rehab is designated as Ontario's burn and electrical injury specialty clinic by the Workplace Safety and Insurance Board. Our Back on Track program specializes in assessing and treating traumatic motor vehicle and work-related injuries. With an intensive, interprofessional approach to rehab, we help patients achieve their maximum level of function at home, in the community, and at work.
